MA MAISON is the triumphant, landmark collaboration between internationally acclaimed choreographer Trey McIntyre and the legendary Preservation Hall Jazz Band. A commission by the New Orleans Ballet Association, MA MAISON made its world debut in 2009 in New Orleans followed by performances on stages as varied as the Hollywood Bowl, The Phillips Center, The Voodoo Music Experience, The Morrison Center, Disney Hall and Lincoln Center. Inspired by the unique sounds and rhythms of New Orleans, Mr. McIntyre approached Creative Director of Preservation Hall Ben Jaffe to collaborate on this groundbreaking work. The dancers of the Trey McIntyre Project are joined onstage by the Preservation Hall Jazz Band, dancing to live, improvised solos. MA MAISON is a homage to the living souls of New Orleans' past, where life and death are immortalized through mourning and dance.

Trey McIntyre Project

TREY MCINTYRE is one of the most sought-after choreographers working today, creating fresh and innovative works for over 20 years. Rooted in classical ballet, Mr. McIntyre's in-demand dances are hip, contemporary and set to a brilliant variety of music from Brubeck and The Beatles to Beethoven and Beck. Since the debut of his first work in 1990 for Houston Ballet, Trey has created over 70 ballets for more than 30 prestigious companies, including American Ballet Theatre, Stuttgart Ballet, Hubbard Street Dance Chicago and Aspen Santa Fe Ballet. In December 2010, McIntyre was selected as one of 50 artists to receive the prestigious 2010 United States Artists Fellowship. The troupe explores the human experience with repertoire that spans rock, classical, jazz, bluegrass and folk music.

The recipients of the MEDAL OF ARTS, the Preservation Hall Jazz Band continues to tour the world, bringing its unique blend of New Orleans harmonies and syncopated rhythms to audiences for over 50 years. Rooted deeply in the traditional New Orleans style, recent projects include landmark collaborations with artists as varied as Pete Seeger, Tom Waits, Jim James, Richie Havens, Del McCoury and Mos Def. Preservation Hall carries the torch of New Orleans culture and history brightly into the 21st Century.
